(a)	The number of vacancies in teaching faculty exists in AIIMS, Delhi and other AIIMS;	The vacancies of teaching Faculties in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar as on 1 st March, 2021 is as under :- (i) Faculty - 115 (ii)Senior Residents - 87 (iii)Junior Residents - 46
(b)	The steps that are being taken to fill these vacancies;	To fill up the vacant Faculty/Non-faculty posts, advertisements are being published regularly in Employment News, Rojgar Samacher, Local News Papers and in the Institute Website. 1. Recruitment process to fill up 108 posts of faculty is under progress. Out of 1212 Non-faculty posts in 56 categories, selection process for 49 categories has already been completed. Except one category of post which was cancelled and other one where the recruitment process is held up as the matter is subjudice, Computer Based Test (CBT) for remaining post has been over and Offer of Appointment shall be issued shortly. 2. To fill up 600 posts of Nursing Officers in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, Computer Based Test through NORCET-2020 by AIIMS, New Delhi has already been completed and document verification of the qualified candidates is under progress. The Central Institute Body in its 4 th Meeting held on 27 th July, 2019 has approved various measures for increasing the faculty strength in New AIIMS. Apart from the above developments, following actions have also been taken to avoid unnecessary administrative delays in recruitment of faculty and non-faculty posts. (i) Governing Body has approved down-grading of post of Additional/Associate Professor to the level of Assistant Professor to fill up vacancy, incase no suitable candidate is available for senior post. (ii) Temporary diversion of posts from one Department to Other Department on Contractual appointment to fill up the vacancies. (iii) Relaxation of essential teaching /Research experience upto one year for SC/ST candidate. (iv) For Regular Recruitment, Half Yearly Calendar of Recruitment is planned. (v) To avoid delay and expedite appointment, one four member HR Sub-Committee has been constituted to accord approval of the selection made by Standing Selection Committee pending Ex-Post facto final approval by Governing Body.

(c)	Whether Government is aware that in private Medical Medical Colleges there is lack of adequate and qualified techno faculties; and	Not related to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
(d)	The steps that are being taken to explore remedy of these vacancies in private Medical Colleges since its reverse effects has long term consequence on health services?	Not Applicable.
