IAP QUIZ-2017 - Every year Indian Academy of Pediatrics (IAP) conducts College, Divisional, Zonal and National level Paediatrics quiz competitions among the undergraduate MBBS students. This year students from AIIMS,Bhuabneswar, Mr Ranjan Sahoo and Miss Rakavi R from 9<sup>th</sup> sem are selected for the Zonal level.

**26**<sup>th</sup> **December 2017-** Interviews were conducted in five phases between July 2017 – October 2017 for selection of Faculties including nursing faculties on regular basis and the results after recommendation of Standing Selection Committee were declared on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and 72 candidates were selected for various Faculty positions in Speciality, Super Speciality and Nursing college of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

AllMS Bhubaneswar has set up a Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) cell with support of RBSK Odisha. This is a collaborative effort between both AllMS and NHM, Health and FW Dept, Govt of Odisha to benefit large number of children suffering from birth defects, disabilities etc. identified under the provisions of RBSK. These services have started with effect from 14th November 2017 and will be provided free of cost to the children. The expenditure will be met by RBSK Odisha and National RBSK Programme. Initially five departments namely Ophthalmology, ENT, PMR, Anesthesiology and Plastic surgery have been roped in at AllMS targeting 10/30 conditions and subsequently it will be extended to other specialities. The RBSK cell is situated on 1st floor in OPD (Ophthalmology section) and children will be seen through referral mechanism under the co-ordinated action of various District Early Intervention Centres (DEIC) throughout the state of Odisha.

#### 18<sup>th</sup> November 2017 – World Diabetes Day 2017

World Diabetes Day 2017 was organised by Department of Endocrinology and Department of CM&FM from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. 


