Accordingly, necessary preparation in terms of bed and ventilators have been done at the hospital since 18 <sup>th</sup> March 2020.
(b)	If so, the details thereof;	(i) Isolation Beds excluding ICU Beds: 198 (ii) ICU Beds : 45 (iii) Ventilators :36
(c)	Whether it is a fact that due to insufficient beds and ventilators in hospitals increase in death of patients have been registered;	No death of patient so far has been registered due to insufficient beds or ventilators at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
