(a)	The details of Bio-medical Waste generated by some hospitals of the Government during COVID-19, State/UT-wise, specially in Maharashtra;	The Quantum of Medical Waste is gradually increasing in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and 30609 Bags (Red, Yellow, Blue, White) having 63337.471 kgs of Bio-medical Waste (BMW) was generated by AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The daily weight of COVID Waste generated is uploaded in the COVID-19 Bio-medical Waste (BMW) Website informed by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).
(b)	Whether steps have been taken by Central Government Hospitals as per Central Pollution Control Board guidelines, to manage and dispose of the huge bio-medical waste generated during COVID-19 Pandemic, if so, the details thereof;	AIIMS, Bhubaneswar adheres to all prescribed procedures for Management and disposal of COVID Waste as per the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) Guidelines for COVID Waste 1,2,3 & 4. This includes: - (i) Information to Local Authority i.e. – Orissa State Pollution Control Board (OSPCB). (ii) Linkage with Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF). (iii) Making arrangements at each point i.e. COVID screening, COVID Ward, COVID Emergency and COVID ICU. (iv) Separate team to handle the COVID Waste. (v) Separate Color-coded bins with double liner. (vi) Use of PPE. (vii) Separate closed vehicle. (viii) Separate temporary collection room. (ix) Disinfection of bins and vehicles with hypochlorite. (x) Ensuring timely collection by CBWTF. (xi) Daily weighing of waste and uploading on Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) authorized website.
(c)	The details of Central Government Hospitals which are equipped with bio-medical waste management facility, State/UT-wise specially Maharashtra; and	AIIMS, Bhubaneswar is well equipped with a Bio-medical Waste Management facility.
