(a)	Whether it is a fact that lack of a proper mechanism to deal with the complaints regarding negligence in treatment of Coronavirus patients exercised by All India Institutes of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) and Central Hospitals has been witnessed and as such the grievances of families affected by Corona virus could not be heard;	AIIMS, Bhubaneswar has a proper mechanism to deal with the complaints regarding negligence in treatment of Corona patients and it has not come across any such complaints/grievances either by patients or relatives of patients till date.
(b)	Whether it is also a fact that many Central Hospitals showed dereliction towards duty in the process of admitting coronavirus patients causing an untimely death of many patients; and	AIIMS, Bhubaneswar has not shown any dereliction towards duty in admitting corona patients causing untimely death.
(c)	Details of death cases of coronavirus patients reported in various AIIMS and Central Hospitals of the country?	At AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, 127 nos. of COVID-19 positive death cases have been reported till date, mostly with comorbidities.
