Guidelines for scientific paper abstracts submission

- Abstracts are expected to be limited to 300 words (exclusive of the title and the authors name)
- Abstracts must be in English (Typed; Times New Roman; Font size 12)
- The abstracts must include; Title, Authors name, Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusion
- The presenting author name must be underlined
- The duration of the presentation will be 10 minutes
- Author's name, designation/affiliation, contact number should be included after the abstract
- The abstract must be sent via email to the organizer at cnecon@aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in
- The paper should not have been presented anywhere else.
- NOTE: The final decision of the presentation will be communicated to the presenter by January 11th, 2022.

Guidelines for E- concept poster presentation

Subtheme for E-poster: "Innovative practice/ideas for implementation of clinical integration."

- Abstracts of the concept poster are expected to be limited to 300 words.
- Online E-concept poster presentation will be permitted.
- All posters should be prepared in English


