## Workshop on Critical Care Management for Nursing Officers held on 05/03/2021 and 06/03/2021

Jhpiego in collaboration with College of Nursing and Dept. of Anesthesiology, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar conducted a Workshop on Critical Care Management for Nursing Officers on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> March 2021 at common room, College of Nursing AIIMS BBSR. The workshop is aimed to orient and enhance the knowledge, confidence and performance while caring critically ill patients.

The training programme was attended by fifteen Nursing Officers from different critical care areas of the hospital.

The workshop officially inaugurated by the Honorable Director, Prof. Gitanjali Batmanabane, in presence of Deputy Director (Admin) Mr. P.K. Ray, Medical Superintendent Dr. Sachidananda Mohanty, Joint Medical Superintendent Dr. Jawahar S.K. Pillai, Chief Nursing officer Dr. Asha. P. Shetty, Jhpiego state program manager Dr. Nochiketa Mohanty and Nursing Superintendent Dr. Mahalingam Venkatesan, by watering the plant. Faculty from various departments graced the event.

Mr. Beni Kamalzen, I/C, Casualty, discussed the triaging of critically ill patients and Ms. Manjula Kumari, DNS explained the oxygen delivery devices followed by hands on session for the same.





Dr. P. Bhaskar Rao, additional Professor, Dept. of Anesthesiology, highlighted the basics of mechanical ventilation. Dr. Jayant Kumar Mitra, additional professor, Dept. of Anesthesiology explained the noninvasive ventilation, followed by a session on trouble shooting of ventilator by Dr. Alok Kumar Sahoo, Asst. prof., Dept. of Anesthesiology.



ICU In-charges Ms. Truptirani Sahoo, Mr. Bhima Surendra Babu, Mr. Jayesh. K, Ms. Harapriya Bal demonstrated the setting up of ventilator and care of patients on ventilator. Mr. Vysakh.P, Nursing supervisor explained various alarms in the ventilator and the measures to rectify the errors.





On day-2, the program started with the recap of day one session. Ms. Soma Bhaktha AND Ms. Priyadarshini Sahoo, Nursing Supervisor demonstrated the monitoring of critically ill patients and investigations.

Dr. Mahalingam Venkatesan, nursing superintendent discussed and demonstrated post-crash management scenarios.



Dr. Asha. P. Shetty, Chief Nursing Officer, highlighted the infection control practices in ICU followed by the demonstration of infection control practices.



Participants scored 92% in the post test which showed the programme is successful in imparting the knowledge on the care of critically ill patients.
